Congregational Meeting TODAY - June 10 – after Worship

At the April 26/18 Church Council meeting, the following motions were passed and now need to be taken to the Congregation for approval:

- a) "That we authorize Duncan roofing to proceed with the shingling of the church roof at a cost of approximately \$130,000. Funding to be determined."
- b) "That Council take to Congregation three options for paying for roof rehabilitation:
 - 1) fund entirely from Church reserves or from Planned Giving,
 - 2) fund from fundraising with loan for remainder,
 - 3) half from existing Church funds and half from fundraising/loan."
- c) "That we purchase two new projectors for the sanctuary, from Voth's Country Wide, at a cost of \$24,306.87."
- d) "That funds needed for the projector which are not provided by UCW or the memorial fund will come from church operating fund reserves pending congregational approval."

Information will be provided and there will be time for questions and answers. Please plan to attend.
