The Growth initiative represents the leading priority of the <u>Strategic Plan</u> of The United Church of Canada. Working with the Growth Team will be the newly hired Director of Growth and Ministry Development, the Rev. Cameron Fraser, who is concluding ministry leadership at Knox-Metropolitan in Regina. Join us in praying for those who will discern a call to engage in this vital work.
