Financial Request from the Refugee Sponsorship Group

Rising financial pressures for our sponsorship family in Egypt and a backlog of immigration cases at Immigration Canada have prompted the Refugee Sponsorship Group to commit to offering some private financial support to subsidize the family for the next six months, at which point we will assess the need to continue or not. If you feel that you are also able to give some financial help, whether large or small, that would be much appreciated. *This would be over and above our other fundraising efforts, and these monies would <u>not</u> be eligible for tax receipts.*

Maxine Olmsted will be collecting the funds for deposit in a designated banking account, and funds will be transferred monthly to the family. The goal is to provide the equivalent of \$400.00 US each month.
