Toiletries for All Ages: - shampoo & conditioner (full size), body wash/lotion, makeup remover wipes, nail clippers, women's deodorant, feminine hygiene products, bubble bath for women and children, travel size Q-tips, hair accessories (including pony tail holders, curling iron, blow dryers, straightener and products for hair care).
