- ONE: The Hebrew Scriptures do not hide the truth, About women being subjected to violence
- ALL: As Being the Truth, Even among God's People.
- ONE: Say their names: Violence against Women and Girls, Disproportionately experienced by Indigenous Families,
- ALL: Is a lineage of names reaching back in time.
- ONE: We come to worship with Creator, Whose preference is for those who are hurting,
- ALL: Who is moved to act by the tears of suffering, Who comforts the grieving and sorrow-filled.

ONE: We come to join our hearts to Creator's heart.
