DID YOU KNOW?

The **Nature Conservancy of Canada** has a plan to protect 500,000 hectares of Prairie grasslands by 2030. Over 80% of Canada's grasslands have been lost already. That's 80% less carbon-storing land, 80% less of land purifying water and mitigating flood risks, 80% less habitat for grassland species. Projects nearby include Jackson Pipestone Prairie and Wetlands, and Mackie Ranch around Chaplin Lake, an internationally significant lake for shorebirds.
